All of the books and other materials in the Bookmobile's collection are fine free! This means you will never be charged a late fee, regardless of when you return the book.

*However, items borrowed from the Fall River Public Library still have late fees.

Damaged/Lost Materials

If any materials from the Bookmobile's collection are damaged/lost while checked out, the user's card will be charged the listed price to replace it.

*Once you have \$10.00 or more charged onto your card, you will be blocked from borrowing until payment is made.

What is the Bookmobile?

The Bookmobile is a mobile branch of the Fall River Public Library. Our main goal is to improve access to library materials, increase visibility, and provide services to underserved groups within our community.

The Collection



The Bookmobile collection has over 4,000 books, audiobooks, large print books, reference materials, DVDS, and games. This collection has materials for children, teens, and adults

Library Cards



Adults

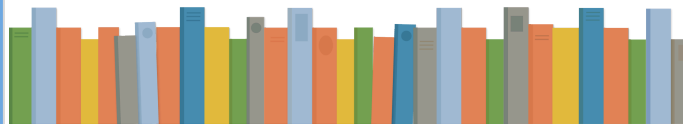
A library card must be presented for any transactions. Cards are issued for free at the Bookmobile's circulation desk. To obtain a library card, you must present a picture ID and proof of address. Fall River cardholders have borrowing privileges at all SAILS member libraries.

Children/Young Adults

A child may obtain a SAILS Library card at any age at which they are able to write their first and last name. Any application for a borrower's card submitted by a person under the age of 18 must be signed in person by their parent or legal guardian, and the responsible adult must provide a picture ID and proof of address.

Borrowing Policy

- Borrowers must have a SAILS library card with them to check out any materials from the Bookmobile's collection.
- Materials will be checked out for an initial period of 2 week. Items can be renewed up to 2 times after the initial checkout.



Internet Access

The Bookmobile will provide free access to Wi-Fi during designated programming hours with a T-Mobile Hotspot.

Placing Holds

- Materials in the Bookmobile collection cannot be placed on hold for users. However, requests for specific items can be made prior to your scheduled visit.
- Users of the Fall River Public Library cannot place Bookmobile materials on hold to pick up at the main branch.

Returns

Material borrowed from the Bookmobile can be returned one of two ways.

1. Directly to the Bookmobile staff during your next scheduled visit.
2. Returned to the Fall River Public Library at one of the main circulation desks or the Elm Street Book Drop.
