For the week of **DEC. 15: Please bring one of the following:** ready-made meals such as rice-a-roni, hamburger helper, canned beef stews, chunky soups, chef-boy-ar-dee pastas. (They don't need any more mac and cheese, tuna or beans)

In lieu of the above items, they will also accept gift cards for Price Rite, Stop and Shop, Walmart and Market Basket.

You can access Care Solace services in three ways:


