Providing scholarships since 1991, **The Foundation to Advance Catholic Education** awards need-based scholarships to assist with the tuition costs for students attending a Catholic school in the Diocese of Fall River. All families with one or more children enrolled in or applying to a Catholic elementary or middle school in grades **K-8** in the Diocese of Fall River are eligible to apply. FACE uses the FACTS system to determine financial need so that each situation can be fairly assessed for scholarship opportunities.

It is very important to complete your application by the deadline to ensure your family is considered for scholarship opportunities.

A new application must be completed for returning students each year.

- **2022** IRS FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURN, INCLUDING ALL SUPPORTING SCHEDULES.
- ALL **2023** W-2 WAGE AND TAX STATEMENTS FOR BOTH THE APPLICANT AND CO-APPLICANT.
- **IF YOU DO NOT HAVE W-2 INCOME PLEASE SUBMIT YOUR 2023 FEDERAL TAX RETURN.**

There is a \$40 per family non-refundable application fee.
