Reminder about Drinks: Please note that students are permitted to drink water during the school day. Students are not allowed to drink coffee, energy/sugary drinks or similar items during the school day. Also, please be sure that your student has a refillable (plastic or metal) bottle, so they may utilize our bottle fill station. Thank you for your cooperation!

Reminders from the School Nurse: (Contact Nurse Carrier at scarrier@es.dfrcs.org)

- 1) Students who require medication during the school day must have a doctor's order.
- 2) If your student is out for three days, a doctor's note is required in order for them to return.
- 3) Please remember that if your student has a fever, they must remain home for 24 hours, and must be fever-free without fever reducing medication upon return.

If you wish, you may deliver **individually packaged snacks** to be served at snack time or at a time determined by the teacher and at the Principal's discretion. We ask that you notify the school ahead of time by calling the school nurse. All snacks must be peanut-free/nut free, and it must be on the label. Please contact the school nurse regarding this.
