As we prepare to begin the new school year, here are some announcements:

Important Dates Coming Up:

- Pre-School/Pre-Kindergarten/Kindergarten Open House: This Thursday @ 6:00pm:
 - o For our PS/PK & K families, please come to the school to meet your classroom teachers, and learn the procedures for drop-off/pickup.
- Drop off your School Supplies: August 24th @ 6:00pm & August 27th @ 1pm:
 - All families are strongly encouraged to drop off the student school supplies ahead of time, to make the 1st day of school as seamless as possible. Please be sure to label your students items, so they go to the correct classroom.
- 1st Day of School: August 29th (1/2 Day of School):
 - School begins on Tuesday, August 29th. The 1st day of school will be a ½ day. Dismissal is at 11:20am for Grades K-3, at 11:30am for Grades 4-8, and begins at 11:00am for PS & PK. Lunch will not be served on the 1st day of school. The rest of the week will be full days of school.
- Open Parent Night: September 5th @ 6:00pm:
 - This is our open parent night for the remainder of the building (Grades 1-8). Please come visit with your student's classroom teachers.

Lunch Program: I am pleased to share that Espirito Santo School will be joining the Fall River Public School Nutrition program. This means that breakfast and lunch will be made available **free** to our students. A menu will be sent to the school from FRPS, and then will be forwarded to parents. Each morning, we will take a count of students who need hot lunch, and will notify FRPS. More information will be available shortly.

Welcome to Ms. Raposo: I am proud to announce that Ms. Jacqueline Raposo has joined our school team! She is now the 1st grade teacher. Ms. Raposo is an alumni of Espirito Santo School, and Bishop Connolly High School. She also graduated from Rhode Island College. Documents to Be Returned: On the 1st day of school, your student will receive some documentation that will need to be signed and returned. Please be sure to return them to the school by the 2nd day of school. This is very important that we receive these documents in a timely manner.

Tuition Statements: Tuition payments are due at the beginning of each month, per the tuition agreements that were mailed to you. You can mail your payment to the school. You can also schedule your payments with bill pay through your banking partner, where they will be mailed to the school on your behalf.
