Reminders from the School Nurse: (Contact Nurse Carrier at scarrier@es.dfrcs.org)

- 1) Students who require medication during the school day must have a doctor’s order.
- 2) If your student is out for three days, a doctor’s note is required in order for them to return.
- 3) Please remember that if your student has a fever or vomiting, they must remain home for 24 hours, and must be symptom free.

Reminder about Birthdays – From the Student/Parent Handbook: Birthday parties are more appropriately held at home. If you wish, you may deliver **individually packaged snacks** to be served at snack time or at a time determined by the teacher and at the Principal’s discretion. Registration for the 6 week After School Program at Espirito Santo Elementary School will be done entirely on-line using Mad Science's secure site. You do not need to provide any credit card or other financial information to register, and we do not share or use your e-mail address for any purpose other than communication. *(If you do not have internet access, you can call our office at the number above and register by telephone.)*

1. Navigate to the Registration website <https://MadScienceSMARI.com/Register>
2. Find the class for "Espirito Santo Elementary School" and click "select" on the right.
3. If it says "Call to Register", then it is past the registration deadline of 4/24/23 or registration has been closed. Call Mad Science at 508-679-0081.
4. Click "Sign in or Create Account". If you have not registered previously, there is a form to provide information for you and your children.
5. Update your child's **Grade** and **Teacher** as required and click "Select". (If the class is Full click "Wait List".)
6. Provide after class pick-up information and click the "Register Children" button.
7. Verify the information on the next screen and click "Checkout".
8. Select "Cash / Check / Money Order" for payment, verify that you have read and agree to the *Terms & Conditions*, and click "Purchase".
9. The next screen will display an invoice, and you will be e-mailed a copy. If you do not see the invoice, *your children are not registered!*
10. Mail payment to the Mad Science office (77 Weaver St, Unit A, Fall River, MA 02720), send it in on the first day of class, or call Mad Science (508-679-0081) with credit card information.
